Meeting Minutes
May 31, 2016

Call to Order: Barnes called the meeting to order at 6:10 pm.

Directors' Report: The season at Ware's Grove has started strongly due to the hot weather on Memorial Day weekend. There have been \$5,201.25 in ticket/season pass sales. Profit after one week is \$3,500.14.

There is an issue at North Shore with the water/well – Peter is looking into it. He will call Gary Winn about the circuit breaker at North Shore and also get new locks.

The potential loss of sales from not taking credit cards was addressed and possibility of using the paypal account for this purpose. There's a new Instagram page for Ware's Grove that anyone can follow. Peter has met with Sean Graves and discussed the summer rec program and supplies needed. They will come up with a CIT program for kids who are too old for the rec program. The program will be free this year but will have a cost next year. There are plans for movie nights on the beach. The refrigerator is broken at the cottage and needs to be replaced. The weed whacker and leaf blower need to be taken to Tucker's for maintenance. Peter asked if the wi-fi signal could be boosted since it is not available in the cottage. Perhaps another router could be provided.

Peter will talk to Rick about the amount of money left over in the budget for final cottage repairs.

Peter requested two days off in advance – June 25th and August 6th. The two head lifeguards will be in charge during his absence.

There will be a new rental charge of \$25 for the picnic area. The fee for before and after care is \$12.00 and it covers both 7:30-8:30 am and 4:30-5:30 pm.

Future meetings are June 13th at Ware's Grove and June 28th at town office.

Adjournment

With no other business to conduct, a motion was made by Condosta to adjourn at 7:20 pm. Barnes seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
