Call to Order: Barnes called the meeting to order at 6:22 pm.

Old Business:

Director's Report: Dan Robel presented a list of maintenance items to be added to the 2016 budget. These include wooden picnic tables, grills, lifeguard seat, beach fence sections, leach field fencing, swim dock, megaphone, plastic Adirondack chairs, recycle buckets, swing set .paint, concession stand paint, popcorn maker parts, beach drag, lawnmower & four-wheeler tune-up, railroad ties, landscaping supplies, first aid supplies & AED. 13 background checks will be needed for 2016. IPads may be purchased for taking credit cards. The Ware's Grove telephone has been suspended for the winter. Paypal is now working on the website. Discounted Mount Snow tickets will be sold for either 4, 5, or 6 weeks. One Chesterfield soccer team won the Putney tournament, both teams won the sportsmanship award. Adult pickup games will take place at the school Monday through Thursdays evenings from 7 to 9. Dan is researching the costs of an ice rink as well as before and after school child care.

New Business: There was discussion about two possible evaluation templates for Dan Robel as beach manager and parks & rec director. Joann Condosta would like to start a sewing and quilting program.

Dewey Auger asked for funding of participation by 9 field hockey players in the Jamboree in Bernardston.

Condosta made a motion to approve funding of \$275.00 from the revolving fund. LaFontaine seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Discussion of youth sports programs prices and potential increases took place.
