- 1). Communication – Ghost Hunters were at Madame Sherri’s last month.
- 2). Pam moved to approve July 14<sup>th</sup> as submitted. The motion was seconded by Lynne and passed unanimously.
- 3). Permits, Complaints, etc.-
  - A). Ann & Neil Connolly – Permit by Notification Repair existing retaining wall. Notice of incomplete application Sept 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - B). Val & Jon Starbuck – Permit by Notification Repair existing retaining wall. Application signed August 28<sup>th</sup>.
  - C). Bruce & Arla Bain – LRM File #2014-01940 complaint for 90 North Shore Road.
  - D). Theresa Brewer – LRM File #2014-01632 complaint for 16 White Birch Drive. DES did not find evidence of a violation and will close the file.
  - E). Richard & Kristin Wells – LRM File #2014-01927 complaint for 88 North Shore Road. Letter of Deficiency
  - F). Frank Amarosa, III – LRM File #2014-01941 complaint 90 North Shore Road. Possible Violations on a 50 foot ROW.
  - G). Forecastle Timber, LLC. Wetlands Minimum Impact Forestry Notification.
  - H). State of NH Pisgah Park Forestry Notification.
  - I). Marilyn George – Anonymous Complaint 16 Tyler Road.
- 4). Grants, Events –
  - A). Lynne is working on a Fields Pond Grant.
  - B). There is an event at Madame Sherri’s at 10 AM Saturday.
  - C). Tom & Lynne will be meeting Thursday at 5 to install plexiglass at Madame Sherri’s.
- 5). Spofford Lake Report –
  - A). The lake is at 26” below. Winter level is 30.
  - B). The Lake Host program ran over by about \$2,000 this year because of evening hours.
  - C). DOT began work on Route 63 on September 16<sup>th</sup>. Tree cutting is complete, Shore line has been taken away and trees have been cut down.
- 6). Tools – Need to follow up on the registration for the trailer.
- 7). Trail Development & Land Projects –
  - A). Tom is working on getting a plaque for the Oak Tree in Friedsam Forest.
  - B). Complaints about non-motorized access on Prouty Road; In 2002, Town votes to convert Prouty Road to a Class A Trail (RSA 231-A:1); 2009 Selectmen vote to prohibit motorized use of Prouty Rd (RSA 41-11; RSA 231-A:4)
  - C). The forester at Colony Pond is going to build a bridge.
