

Chesterfield Cemetery Commission Meeting - August 14, 2018

Meeting called to order at 6:40 p.m.

Draft minutes from July 10, 2018 meeting were approved.

Chris Flagg reported the following:

- The tree that fell in the West Cemetery on Welcome Hill Rd. is gone. There were a total of 10 stones affected. Some have been repaired already, others are scheduled for repair and a few others may need additional scrutiny to determine the best course of action to take.
- The tree in Pattridge-Albee Cemetery has not yet been removed. There are not as many stones affected in that cemetery but the tree will be more difficult to remove.
- Chris will be gone from August 22 - September 4 and Gary will have the phone.
- There was a full burial performed yesterday (Lucille Dean) in Friedsam Cemetery. There is a cremation scheduled for Chesterfield West on August 27.
- Cemetery signs have been purchased for the final three cemeteries (Preshoe - Butler - Wetherby) that hadn't had updated signs installed. All cemeteries now have newer, consistent signage stating the name of the cemetery.
- Bad News: There were mechanical difficulties with the truck to the tune of @ \$2900. Despite this, the cemetery budget in it's entirety still looks good and overall like all will still be OK.
