Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pat motioned for July minutes to be approved. Ed seconded. Minutes from July 9, 2019 were approved as written.

Sexton report:

- Zack has had his surgery and will be 2 weeks in recovery so will be unable to help with fall clean-up although there are other smaller jobs he can perform before season's end.
- Classified ads in the Sentinel yielded no good prospects for maintenance employees.
- Chris will be back from vacation on Sept. 3. Tom will have the phone in his absence.
- The mower has been fixed and now has a warranty.
- Chris was able to repair 6 or 7 headstones since last meeting.
- Despite mower repair expense, the budget is still expected to end up OK.

Discussion progressed to asking about potential upcoming projects. Three were mentioned:

- 1) Looking at paving Spofford Cemetery road
- 2) Coming up with a more long-term fix for the white fencing in Chesterfield West. Right now slats are deteriorating and need to be replaced & repainted. Looking into feasibility of plastic wood to be used for slats. Would negate deterioration and the need for painting at all. Is expensive though.
- 3) At least two cemeteries (Castle & New Boston) have sections of stone wall that look like they want to fall down. When that happens it will be dealt with. Right now they are being monitored.
