

Spofford Fire District Commissioners Meeting September 17th, 2020

Evan James Deutsch called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Present: (Chairmen) Evan James Deutsch, Commissioner John Forester, Commissioner Rob Hodgkins, Treasurer Cathy Schlichting, Chief Steve Dumont, Clerk Tim Scanlon.

Bills and Correspondents: The bills were reviewed and discussed between the Commissioners and the Treasurer. They were approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the past meeting were handed out by Tim Scanlon. Evan Deutsch made a motion to approve the minutes as read, the motion was seconded by John Forester. All were in favor.

Old Business:

IRS: Pending.

Grants: Steve stated that he received word that we did not receive the Fire House Subs grant and the State of New Hampshire grant for a defibrillator. He did however hear that we did receive a grant from the State of New Hampshire for PPE.

Chairmen's Report: Evan received an email from the Town of Chesterfield as a reminder that the budget meetings will be starting up shortly and to make sure that our representatives will be present for those meetings.

Treasurer's Report: Cathy brought up that she has noticed that items have been getting order and that they are not being billed to the District's PO Box. Cathy also brought up that the District should start addressing next years budget plans starting next month, the Commissioner's agreed to that.

Chief's Report: Steve stated that the foam system on Engine 1 has been down since Valentine's Day. Steve had a company come out and give a quote to fix it. He has received two quotes so far for the repair and is still waiting for the third. He also brought up that the foam system on Tanker 1 has also broke down. The system is under warranty and Steve is waiting to hear back from the company about repairing it.

Building Maintenance: John still had not received a third quote for the lights in the station. The Commissioner's decided to table this till next meeting.

New Business:

Rob Hodgkins made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:15pm. The motion was seconded by John Forester. Motion passed unanimously.
