

**CHESTERFIELD
FIRE & RESCUE PRECINCT
MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 30, 2021**

Present: George Wright, Crystal Winn and Rick Cooper, Fire Chief.

Vice-Chair George Wright called the meeting to order at 7:06 PM.

The heat tape in the basement of the old Town Office had been unplugged. There was a blown elbow in the tank. Gary Winn and Rick Cooper turned on water to Fire Station at the new Town Office Complex and water poured out of the blown elbow after the meeting on March 28th. It was determined that the water goes from the Old Town Building to the New Town Office Complex to the Fire Station. The Pipe has been fixed and the water to the Fire Station is now working.

The Commissioners were concerned about the potential occupants of the Old Town Office Building having control of the Fire Station water. It had been discussed at the Joint Meeting on March 28th about potentially limiting the water for the lessee of the Old Town Office Building. Joel Kinson was present as a potential excavator. He suggested not disturbing area or landscaping unless necessary. The Commissioners agreed to wait for further guidance from the Selectboard after their April 7th meeting.

Rick asked about getting gas for the individual driving their car down to inspect the new truck in Foxboro. It was discussed reimburse for mileage or buy a gas card.

George moved to adjourn at 7:36 PM. The motion was seconded by Crystal and passed unanimously.
